I set my hand and seal this 16th day of September 1825 -

estate not mentioned herein -

Finally I do hereby constitute declare & appoint my beloved
son in law named Nathan Henry my friend Henry Chapman and Es-
tate my last will & testament hereby revoking & cancel-
ing all former wills by me made before this day of signing this
one after the day first will & testament hereby revoking & cancel-
ing all former wills by me made before this day of signing this
one after the day first will & testament the last will &
testament of my son & wife my wife this 15th day of

Finally I do hereby testify, declare & appoint my beloved
Son in law Samuel Lathem & my friend Henry Chapman and Esq.
to be my last Will & Testament, hereby testifying & concluding
all former writing made or to be made concerning this and
some other to be my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof
I have signed & dated this & given my Seal this 15th day of October
in the year of our Lord 1825 & of the Independence of the United
States the 49th.

At the 15th of Oct. 1825 I left to James Parry to remain
with Samuel Lathem about for two years and it not right

to go to Samuel Lathan's children -

Glover, Nancy Weather and the above mentioned Henry
Glover, John Glover & Joseph Glover and my deceased daughter
Rebecca Smith the Mother of the three above mentioned little
children
