James and his or his Heirs— 3rd I give & bequeath
unto Andrew Hays and his or his Heirs—

4th I give and bequeath unto my grand Daughter, Infant Latham
my small share of Lays Child 5th I give & bequeath to my
grand Daughter Martha Latham my land & Stock—

6th I give and bequeath unto my three grand Daughters
Martha Latham Infant Latham and Jane Latham all the
effects of my Estate not mentioned herein—

7th I do hereby constitute Ordain and appoint my beloved Son
in Law Sam^l Latham & my friend Henry Lloyd of Litchfield
Executor to this my Last Will & Testament hereby revoking
and annulling all former by me made & signing this
and no other to be my Last Will & Testament.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
affixed my Seal this 13th day of Feb^r 1833 and
at the Independence of the United States 19th

My Fifty Dollars willow to James Craig is to
remain in the hands of Sam^l Latham for two years
and if not called for by proper authority in the two
years the money is to go to Sam^l Latham's Children
