one small White & Long Coat 3rd I give & bequeath to my
grand Daughters Martha Sathan one silk Dress

4th I give and bequeath unto my dear grand Daughters
Martha Sathan Isabell Sathan and Anna Sathan all the
effects of my Estate not mentioned herein —

My Testimony concerning these bequests let my heirs &
affid my death this 13th day of Octo^r 1818 / 89th and
of the Independence of the United States 19th

Ms. in Fifty Dollars to James Gray is to
remain in the hands of Samuel Sathan for five years
and if not called for by proper authority in the five
years the money is to go to Anna Sathan

as my last Will and Testament in presence of me
