Item 5th I bequeath to my Daughter Chella Davis one Dollar.
Item 6th I bequeath to my daughter Nancy one Dollar. ✓
Item 7th I bequeath to my Daughter Martha one Dollar. ✓
Item 8th I bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Beatty, my Negro Woman
Pest, and all my Crop now in the Ground, and all my
Horses, Cows, Hogs, Sheep, and all my beds & furniture, and
all other property whatever Belonging to me by will of
Samuel Beatty Deceased or otherwise, In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 8th day of June in
the year of our Lord 1825.

bequeath to my Son George & Sarah Flanigan, my Cow & calf,

I will to Sarah my breeding clothes to do as she pleases with them
she has the first right to them. I will that if there is any money
got for me from S. Hale, in collection of my debts that is owing

To me, that Adeline gets what will get her a wheel &

dery being in the same County & Wales exposed facing
the River Black, James Morris, Domenec Gresius, Robert
Hamill, Hirs & Samuel Pendle — Item It is my will
that Jane Fasson have the use of the plantation for three
years — Item. It is my will & pleasure that my Daughter
Elizabeth have one Doller of my estate — Item. It is my
will & pleasure that Charlotte Pendle Robert daughter
have my bed & other & furniture. — Item. It is my will &
pleasure that Jane Fasson have my corner cupboard —
Lastly I hereby constitute & appoint Peter M'Call
my Executor of this my last will & Testament
In witness whereof I the said John Fasson have
hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 2. day
of May in the year of our Lord 1828
and that was in presence of each other said the above
named John Fasson sign here & acknowledge
the above to be his last will & Testament
