Item 5th I bequeath to my Daughter Chilly Davis one Dollar -
Item 6th I bequeath to my daughter Nancy one Dollar ✓
Item 7th I bequeath to my Daughter Martha one Dollar ✓
Item 8th I bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Beely, my Negro woman
Pest, and all my Crops now in the Ground, and all my
Horses, Cows, Hogs, Sheep, and all my beds & furniture, and
all other property whatever belonging to me by will of
Samuel Beely Deceased or otherwise; In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 8th day of June in
the Year of our Lord 1825.

I will to Sarah my wearing clothes to do as she pleases to them
she has the best right to them -- I will that if there is any money
got for me from the State, in collection of my Debts that is owing

that same have the use of the plantation for three
years - *Item*. It is my will & pleasure that my Daughter
Elizabeth have one Dollar of my Estate - *Item*. It is my
will & pleasure that Charles Wendell Robert & daughter
have my bed & Head & furniture, - *Item*. It is my will
& pleasure that same have my corn cupboard -
Lastly I hereby constitute & appoint John McCall
my Executor of this my last will & Testament
In Witness whereof I the said John Farson have
hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 8th day
of May in the year of our Lord 1828
