 son David Morrow my Negro James Solomon & my  
 Martha, Charles & Emberson to have the immediate  
 labor & profits of said Negroes during his natural  
 lifetime, and at the death of my son David Morrow  
 to be divided as follows my Negro boy James to my grandson  
John Morrow, my Negro boy Solomon to my grandson  
Eli Morrow, my Negro woman Dorcas & boy Martha to my  
 grandson David Morrow, my Negro girl Charlotte to my  
 Grand daughter Jane Morrow, my Negro child Emberson  
 & the first born child of my girl Martha to my Grand  
 daughter Martina Morrow my Grand children above  
 mentioned are the children of my son David Morrow -  
 I will & bequeath unto my grandson William Morrow  
 of James Morrow Desc. my Negro boy Allen to have  
 as his property at my death -

I will & bequeath that all my household & kitchen furniture  
 & other little and ~~valuable~~ things I may have that is not  
 mentioned before to be divided between the persons after my  
 last debts are paid to ~~be~~ equally divided between my  
 daughters Ann, Elizabeth, Rebecca, Margery  
Myers, Jane & Martina children of Margaret Walden  
 And I hereby make & declare my lawful heirs - -  
James Gooden & Wesley Houston Executors of this my  
 last will and Testament. In witness whereof I the  
 said Martina Morrow to this my last will and  
 Testament set my hand & seal the day and year  
 above written.
