 & in the ninth year of the Independence

 in the presence of me

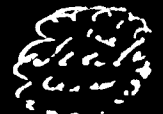

 think it my duty to make & constitute this my last Will
 & Testament in the following manner; - First I do

five shillings Sterling, Second to my youngest son John
Rhinehead Rogers I do give & bequeath five shillings Sterling
Thirdly To my son in law William Barnett I do give
bequeath five shillings Sterling, Fourthly To my Grand-
daughter Martha I do give & bequeath
fifteen pounds, Fifthly To my Grand daughter Mary
Barnett I give & bequeath fifteen pounds

lastly, I do give & bequeath the remaining part of my for-
-perty to be equally divided between my son Seth Rogers
& my son in law William Welch & my daughter Martine Rogers
& my daughter Sarah Rogers & my daughter Frances Rogers
I do appoint & empower my trusty son Seth Rogers & William
Welch to be Executors of this my last Will & Testament, I do
appoint & empower my trusty son Seth Rogers as Guardian
over my two Grand daughters and to have it in his hands
& to put it to Interest for them his witnesses my hand & seal
this 24th day of September 1785.

body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given to God

my last Will & Testament. First of all I give & recommend into
the hands of Almighty God that gave it & my body I recom-
mend my body to be buried in the Earth in a decent man-
ner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting
but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same
again by the mighty power of God, And as Touching such
worldly estate as where with it has pleased Almighty God
to bless me in this life I give & dispose of it as follows
I give & dispose as follows. First I will & declare that all my
just & lawful debts be paid out of my estate as here after
directed & they whom to be executed & disposed of &c
Secondly I give & bequeath unto Mary Ashe my wife
wife her bed with bed clothes with bedstead & her spin-
ning wheel, & one part & the least of my land holdy to be given
to her first & second, then there shall be at public sale
