In the name of God Amen. The 26th day of March 1789. I Martin Phifer late of this County of Rockingham & State of North Carolina for my Bodye in bodily heat of perfect man & memory make in given unto God Therefore calling unto mind the Inability of my bo. of Writing that I am now in the abl man & estate wherein I make & declare this my last will & Testament. That is to say principally & first of all I give & command my soul into the hand of Almighty God that I may ite Unde my Body to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors whom I shall nominate hereafter in this will, nothing about being laid at the general Resurrection. I shall receive the same again by the Right of Heaven; God long as lasting Touch worldly Estate unto me the place where God doth let me in this life I give & bequeath to my son following manner & form — It is my will that my son and his wife charges be duly paid and discharged. Here I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Margret Phifer one Slave viz one old negro man named Dick Van. Negro man he named. Mary their two children Vane age . n. m. & Dick and the rest my householt furniture & all my Goods Stocks & Chattels & one third part of my Money at hand & like wise the sum in my hands Unto my hand alone to me & also the liberty of sending her self & living as her right of Dower of the lands on which I now live on big Loddwater Creek or both of her son to be left in Martin Phifer on the lands to them herein after described all which I give to my above wife Margret in . her natural life or widowhood & after her decease the said wife

is her above divided & all increase of the negroes shall be
equally divided between my two sons & my two grand children
Peter & Margaret Phifer in three parts, to each of my sons to
part & the third part to be equally divided between my two grand
children Paul & Margaret Phifer children of my son John
Phifer Decd. & if my beloved wife Margaret Should chance
to live on the plantation herein after divided to Paul Phifer
she shall have free habitation to choose her seat
I give & bequeath to my beloved grandson Paul Phifer son of my
son John Phifer Decd. & to his male issue lawfully begotten my old
plantation with the tract of Land lying on the main wagon
road as leads from Salisbury to Charlotte Town together with all
Houses, Mills, Buildings & other improvements thereon, & likewise
all acre of land joining the said old tract being part of a
tract of Land as bought from John McWay lying on the east side
of the old tract of Land to join McWay's East corner the wagon
Road & likewise two other Tracts joining said old tract one
on the east & one on the west of said old tract, land if the said
Paul Phifer Should die without male issue lawfully begotten
then the houses and lands to fall to my son Charles male Heir
and he Should die without male issue then to fall to the first
male Heir of my son Martin Phifer, and it is my will that
the said lands should remain in said or exchanged tract of the
name of ~~the~~ ^{old} Phifers, and it is my will that the said Paul
Phifer should find all my son Charles Phifer Grain toll free
& all his sisters grain toll free if she Marries & has conve
nient to my said son Charles & his said sister Margaret to assist
him in keeping the mill in repair, likewise I give & bequeath
to my beloved son Paul Phifer two negroes follows me
named David, & the other named Charles a son of old Charles —
Likewise I give & bequeath to my beloved Grand daughter
Margaret Phifer daughter of my son John Phifer Decd two negroes
viz old Charles & Nancy his wife he were beached away & I give
1. an African woman named Grace & her son in lieu of said
Charles & Nancy, and it is my will that the said Paul Phifer
shall let the title estate that I made to Adam Bowers, in fee
in b. Plumb in or about 16... cause to be his Heir of any of my Estates

Sikewere I give to my beloved son Caleb Phifer his Heirs & assigns
in me the following land viz The plantation wherein he now lives
with the improvements thereon, also one third part of all that tract
of land lying on Shucklin's fork of Liles Creek in Rock County
which tract is to include the improvement & mill standing the
lives of Cowan & Robison & Griffith Edwards, & also the remain-
der of that tract of Land which I possessed of John A. Corp -
after Paul gets his fifty acres, also I give to my son Caleb Phifer
four negroes Viz James & Diana his wife & all their increase
& David & Fanny his wife & all their increase, and also my
Silver Watch —

Him I give & bequeath to my beloved son Martin Phifer his Heirs
& assigns, or me, The plantation wherein I now live with all the
lands thereto belonging or joining on big Coddwater with all
the buildings & improvements thereon & also the remaining two
thirds of that tract of land lying on Shucklin's fork of Liles
Creek it being the upper part of said tract bearing Dunn's &
Plaid's lands & my son Caleb is to make a Deed of a small tract
at the upper end of said tract to Martin & also I give to my son
Martin the following negroes Viz Old Bob & poll his wife & young son
& Henry & Peter & all their increase & also my horse Brown and
writing Desk. — And I do constitute & appoint my two sons
Caleb Phifer & Martin Phifer to be my Executors of this my
last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills by
me heretofore made. Ratifying & confirming this to be my last
Will & Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & affixed my seal the day & year first above written
Signed, Sealed, published, Pronounced
& declared to be my last Will & Testament
