Item To my grandsons Joseph & David Kennedy I give & bequeath each the sum of ten pounds sterling to be kept at interest for their use & behoof until the be come of age. To my grandson Edward Kennedy I give with one thousand dollars to his wife

had directed that if one or more of them before the time of my Daughter Esther Kennedy shall be removed from this world before they come of man's years, their respective legacies be equally divided among the surviving sons of my Daughter Esther Kennedy & direct that all money sum or sums of money remaining after all the legacies above mentioned are paid off, shall be allotted & hereby bequeathed to my beloved Son Joseph Curran & I hereby declare this to be my last will & Testament, and do disavow & make void all & every will by me heretofore made, and I do also ordain & appoint my beloved Daughter Esther Kennedy & Ephraim Curran to be the executors of this my last will & Testament, not doubting but the will execute the same justly & honestly.
