Item To my Grand sons Joseph L & David Kennedy I give & bequeath each the sum of ten pounds likewise to be kept at Interest for their use & behoof untill they be come of age. To my Grandson Samuel Kennedy I bequeath the sum of five pounds & I will

and direct that if one or more of these Legacies the sons of my Daughter Esther Kennedy, shall be removed from the world before they become of man's years, their respective Legacies be equally divided among the surviving sons of my Daughter I likewise will & direct that all & every sum or sums of money remaining after all the Legacies above mentioned are paid off, shall be allowed & am hereby bequeathed to my beloved son Joseph Carrans & I do hereby declare this to be my last will & Testament, and do disavow & make void all & every will by me heretofore made, and I do also Ordain & Appoint my well beloved Daughters Esther Kennedy & Ephraim Burdett to be the Executors of this my last will & Testament not doubting but they will execute the same justly & honestly.
