strators one riding chair now in possession of & owned by me to  
my daughter Harriet & to Bride wife of Andrew & to Bride Son, 5<sup>th</sup>  
part of my whole Estate not otherwise given or bequeathed for the

And Intent I purport herein after set forth to wit to the use, & for the sole & exclusive use of my daughter Harriet M. B. wife of Andrew M. B. & during the term of her natural life & upon her death to be vested immediately & absolutely in such of her children as may be then living fifthly. The remaining four fifths of my estate I give & bequeath equally between my Daughter Mary Robinson & my son Isaac S. Henderson & my daughter Eliza Smartt & Cornelia Hampton. 6thly For the more convenient performance of the several bequests herein contained I hereby order & direct my whole estate to be sold by my Executors as soon as may be in the mode prescribed by Law. Except two large trunks of glass & one large stand of drawers which I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Robinson 7thly I give & bequeath all my wearing apparel to be equally divided between my daughters Mary Robinson, Eliza Smartt, Cornelia Hampton, and Harriet M. B. & my Daughter in law Lucinda Henderson 8thly I do hereby nominate my Trusty friends Andrew Henderson & Gabriel Alexander Executors of this my last will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 10th day of October 1818 -
