my father died be sold to take as soon after my death by my  
executors as convenient at such a credit as may seem to him best  
calculated the benefit of my creditors & legatees & all my other property  
also which is not heretofore especially bequeathed. Then it is my  
will that all my just debts be just paid out of the proceeds of  
said sale. Then, will I give & bequeath to my sister Jane Doherty  
children two hundred dollars to be divided amongst them  
equally. 2<sup>d</sup> I will & bequeath to my brother Matthew Henderson  
fifty dollars - 3<sup>d</sup> I will & bequeath to my niece Mary Henderson  
daughter of Matthew fifty dollars. 4<sup>d</sup> It is my will that forty  
dollars be laid out to purchase head stone for myself & my sister  
Jane Doherty Dec<sup>r</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> I will & bequeath to my niece Elizabeth  
Doherty my best bed & all the furniture thereunto belonging  
further I will & bequeath to my niece Catherine Houston my  
purses, one calico quilt & a silk dress. I will to my niece  
Lucinda Houston my Table & a calico quilt. further I will &  
bequeath to my sister Jinny Houston my sc. dolls & my black  
silk dress, further I will & bequeath to my sister Souisa Foster  
my bonnet. Then it is my will that the balance of my wearing  
apparel be equally divided between my three nieces Holly Bran,  
Adeline & Elizabeth Doherty. Then it is my will I desire that the residue  
or balance of monies arising from the sale of my property should  
then be paid after paying my just debts & the expenses before men-  
tioned it is my will that said balance go to my two sisters  
children to wit Souisa Foster & Jinny Houston there & share  
a like - Lastly I do constitute nominate & appoint my brother/father  
Robert Pitt my executor to execute this my last will & testament. In  
witness whereof I Polly Henderson the testator, make this 5<sup>th</sup> day  
of September 1825 as before stated to my hand & seal.

Jane Doherty Decr 5<sup>th</sup> I will bequeath to my niece Catharine  
Doherty my best bed & all the furniture thereunto belonging  
further I will bequeath to my niece Catharine to Houston my  
Buness, one calico quilt & silk dress. I will to my niece  
Catharine Houston my Table & calico quilt. further I will  
bequeath to my sister Jensy Houston my saddle & my black  
silk dress, further I will bequeath to my sister Susanna Johnson  
my bonnet. Then it is my will that the balance of my wearing  
apparel be equally divided, between my three nieces Jessy, Catharine  
Susanna Johnson Doherty, Then it is my will & desire that the residue  
or balance of monies arising from the sale of my property should  
then be my after paying my just debts & the legatees before men-  
tioned it is my will that said balance go to my two sisters  
black dress less hundred dollars to my sister Jessy Houston then & there  
to like. Lastly I do constitute nominate & appoint my brother John  
Robert Potts my executor to execute this my last Will & Testament. In  
Witness whereof I Polly Henderson the testator, date this 5<sup>th</sup> day  
of September 1825 as before stated let my hand & seal
