unto my daughter Hannah Hargett the sum of fifty dollars of said

Mary Sperry an equal divide ten the my two above mentioned
daughters of my bedding & furniture & of my clothings; and in like
manner I give & bequeath unto my nine children George Pastor
Hannah Hargett, George Leary, David Leary, Titus Leary, John Leary,
Charles Leary, Mary Sperry, Charles Leary is to have an equal
divide of the balance of my personal estate - And I hereby
make & ordain my last will, friend George Baker executor of
this my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I the said
Mary Leary have to this my last will & Testament set my hand
& seal the day & year above written
Signed & Subscribed & declared by the said
Mary Leary the Testatrix of her last will & Testament
