 Principally I recommend my Soul into the hand of God from
 whom I received it, Nothing doubting but I shall receive the same
 again at the last day by the mighty Power of God, And my body
 I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian man-
 ner at the discretion of my Executors Robert Morrison & William
 Prichard whom I constitute to be the sole Executors of this my last
 will & Testament, And as touching such worldly Estate as it hath
 pleased God to bestow upon me in this life I dispose of the same as
 follows Viz What was left in my husbands will for the maintain-
 ing of the Children is to be at the former Executors disposal, I leave

 dressing of it to be paid & all my other just debts, and the cloth to be
 made into blotters for my Children, I leave my little gown to Sarah
 Ross my other Gown I leave to Jane Hill, and I do Order my Hops to
 be sold for the advantage of my Children - and I do hereby disannul
 & revoke all other wills, Testaments Legacies or Bequests by me at any
 time heretofore made or bequeathed, Ratifying & confirming this
 & no other to be my last will & Testament, In Witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & seal this 7th day of February in the year of our
 Lord 1781. Signed, sealed, published pronounced and
