my last will & Testament in manner & form following & viz
Primarily I recommend my Soul into the hand of God from
whom I received it, Nothing doubting but I shall receive the same
again at the last day by the mighty Power of God, And my body
I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian man-
ner at the direction of my Executors Robert Morrison & William
Prigobal whom I constitute to be the sole Executors of this my last
will & Testament, And as touching such worldly Estate as it hath
pleased God to bestow upon me in this life I dispose of the same as
follows Viz What was left in my husbands will for the Maintain-
ing of the Children is to be at the former Executors disposal, I leave
to my daughters Jane Alice & Mary Morrison all my Household
Furniture to be divided equally between them by my Executors
my large Chest I leave to my daughter Jane & the Bed & Clothes
whereon she lies, this bed whereon I lie & the Spring Matt, I leave
to my Daughter Mary and if Mary dies before the coming of 1845
I allow her part to go to Jane Alice & if Jane Alice dies of her sickness
now, I allow her part to my son Robert and my daughter Mary
& Morrison, I leave my son Robert under Sarah Ross's care

and I allow my daughter Sarah Ross to get what is left to him along
with him and to have it at his death, I leave my mare & saddle to my son
Robert, I leave a Cow to every child I have except James & the remain-
der of my Cattle to be sold & the money equally divided among the
children what money is owing to me of the former Estate I leave to my
son Robert, I allow my spinning wheel to be kept for my daughter
Mary, I leave the Loom & its furniture & big wheel to Jane Ann, I
leave my small chest to my son John, the thick cloth I allow the
dressing of it to be paid & all my other just debts, and the cloth to be
made into blotters for my Children, I leave my little gown to Sarah
Ross my other gown I leave to Jane Ann, and I do bid my Heirs to
be sold for the advantage of my Children - and I do hereby disannul
& revoke all other wills, Testaments Legacies or Bequests by me at any
time heretofore made or bequeathed, Ratifying & confirming this
& no other to be my last will & Testament, In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal this 7th day of February in the year of our
Lord 1781. Signed, sealed, published pronounced and

declared to be my last will & Testament in presence of the
Subscribers who in the presence of each other have subscribed
