this my last will and testament in manner and form following viz:
First, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lucy (Rivers) Garrets
one feather bed and furniture and my mahogany ~~table~~ table and slab
Item I give and bequeath my son, John Rivers one feather bed and furniture
and mahogany desk and also one bay colt, one year old last spring.
Item I give and bequeath unto my son, Thomas Garrete the Tract of land
purchased by my estate after payment of all just debts be sold and
equally divided between Williams Garrete. Stephen Garrete Thomas Garret,
Abraham M. Wade, Charles Hammond, Lucy Garrete and John Rivers or their
lawful heirs and I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my son
Thomas Garrete my lawful executor to carry into affect this my last will
and Testament.
