 Nevertheless should my Executors think it best to sell a
 part or the whole of my land in such case I hereby give them
 full power to make good & sufficient titles for the same &
 the moneys arising from said sale be put into the hands of my
 wife Mary for her comfort & convenience & at her death the
 above sum to be paid out of the balance to be equally
 divided amongst my four daughters viz Elizabeth
 Rosanna, Sarah McHenry, Dorcas Hinnine & Leannah
 Hinnine three & three alike - and I hereby nominate &
 constitute James Wilson my whole & sole executor of this
 my last will & Testament, the witnesses whereof have hereunto
 set my hand & seal this 15th day of October 1829.
