testament, Revoking & disannulling all others but this
& this only Imprecis I give & bequeath to my beloved
daughter Mary Smart five Shillings Sterling taken
Under His power Item I give & bequeath to my beloved son
son in law Thomas Scott Colman five Shillings Sterling
to him & his Heirs forever Item I give & bequeath to my
beloved son Elisha Smart five Shillings Sterling to
him & his Heirs forever Item I give & bequeath to my beloved
daughter Sarah Smart five Shillings Sterling to her & her Heirs
forever Item I give & bequeath to my beloved son James
Smart five Shillings Sterling taking to him & his Heirs forever Item
give & bequeath to my beloved son John Smart including
his half to him & his Heirs forever Item I give & bequeath to my
beloved son George White Smart five Shillings Sterling also
also my share of every kind of household furniture except
what is herein given to others, but he does without law
and His bequeath from his own body, then the property, I
him bequeath shall (by my will) be my beloved son Henry
Smart & his Heirs forever Item I give & bequeath to
my beloved grand daughter Elizabeth Smart my bag
Bags & pocket book, fishing & gunnery and all my
Wearing Clother to her & her Heirs forever

Furthermore It is my will & pleasure that my negro man Jack be left in the freedom of his own will with whom to live during his natural life. Lastly I do hereby declare, Constitute & Express my last will & Testament In the presence of these witnesses set by hand & seal this 26th day of February A.D. 1796

I Robert Summerville being sick of sense & memory, calling to remembrance the mortality of mankind & that it is allotted to man to die. & after our the judgment, I give my soul to God that gave it, I wish allow my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors. Next I allow all my worldly debts to be honestly paid. Next I leave my worldly effects in Mass following First I leave my dear & loving wife the one fourth of all my effects after the debts is all paid Other debts over & above the living of the lame while she remains a widow & at the end of her widowhood I allow the land to two boys William Summerville & John Tom Summerville & my son William my saddle tree & above. I allow my daughter Nancy Summerville a child part of the effects exclusive of the Land & my son Willi: m to give him a new Saddle if she lives to the years of eighteen, I list my children to be well Schooled each of them out of the sum there, I allow Joseph Moore land. & John Johnston to be mylegate & sole executors, I do disannul & disall. & revoke all other will or wills hereof you made & this to be my last will & Testament, I hereunto set my hand & seal to this 26th day of June 1796.
