all my racing apparel to be equally divided between Brother
Matthew Koon & David Koon I begone to lay the plantation that is between
David & me I begin with him my half of it and I begone with
James Fager my best Hat. And I do hereby for ever Ratify &
confirm all Gifts Bequests & Legacies by me formerly granted and
I appoint & constitute my beloved wife Mary Koon my Executrix
& William Pitts & James Fager my Executors to see this my last
will & testament put into execution & do hereby renounce all
other wills & wills Testament & Testaments. In witness whereof have

Carolina being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory
thank to God for the same. Do make & ordain good calling to mind the
mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men
once to die, Do make & ordain this my last will & Testament & provide
justly & first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it
my body to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner, nothing
doubting but I shall receive the same again by the mighty power
of God; And as touching such worldly estate wherewithal it shall
please God to bless me in this life, I give & devise of the same in
maner & form following that is to say, In the first place I give &
bequeath to my Daughter Jane Garrison my negro girl named Hannah
for only proper use of her & her heirs for ever & secondly it is my will that I do

May it not be said that the family...

I give & bequeath to my son Robert one hundred & ten dollars to be levied out of my Estate & the child's part of my books. I give unto bequeath to my son James the one half of my plantation I have in including my lands & saving said tract to be equally divided between him & my son James, upon condition that he the said James shall live on the same & give up his right upon them that no one shall sell them. And without the full consent of the other last in case they cannot agree themselves in the division of the Land it is my choice the said Hugh Herren, Joseph Swan & James Hart to their affiance; & after the division is made it is my will that my son John have his choice which half he shall occupy & possess the said Land & premises shall be for the only proper use of them & their Heirs forever.

I give & bequeath to my Daughter Margaret my Negro Girl named Anna for her only proper use of her & her Heirs forever, allowing her not to be sold out of the family, also my daughter will my neg. Blanket & Sheets,

I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth my negro fellow named Ned & my small Table. - I give & bequeath to my friend son Matthew Young Sixty dollars to be paid off my debts & paid by my son James to him he lives to the age of twenty one years.

I give & bequeath to my son Berry Young one Silver dollar.

I give & bequeath to my Grand daughter Louise Price a Cow & a Blanket.

It is my will that my negro fellow Anna remain on my land & kitchen to be equally divided between my sons John & James, and that my negro man Ned & Ned be set free & at full liberty to live for rest of his life & consideration that she live among my children to have the only & proper use of her & also that she shall have a Cow, & wheel & sheep & Hogs & hens to go by her own name, I also will that my large Table shall be given to my son John & saddlebag & blanket, and my Chest & blanket & clothing not made up to my son James, and that my book be equally divided amongst my children, reserving it on the most & largest of my children on penalty of forfeiting their part thereof, and that any Debt I am in shall be levied out of my Stock, & the remainder to be divided equally between my daughters Jane & Margaret, and that my farmings implements shall be for the use of my son James, and my farm & farm lands shall be left to him, and that my son John get

reducing my lands & dividing them between
him & my son James, upon condition that he the said son shall
live on the same encumbering upon them that no one shall sell them.

Sixty dollars to be paid off my debts & paid by my son John
James before he arrives to the age of Twenty one years -
I give & bequeath to my son Berry Young one Silver dollar -
I give & bequeath to my Grand daughter Louisa Price a Cow & a Blanket
It is my will that my Negro fellow shall remain on my land & kitchen
to be equally divided between my sons John & James, and that my Negro
woman Nan & Benah be set free & have liberty to live for myself upon
condition that she live among my children to have the only
proper & also that she shall have a Cow, & wheel & Sheek & Hogs etc which
go by her own name, I also will that my large Table shall be given to
my son John & saddlebag & books, and my Chest & Cupboard for which
being not made up to my son James, and that my Cook be equally divided
amongst my children, reserving it on them not to dispose of any of them
in penalty of forfeiting their part thereof; and that any Debt I am in
shall be paid out of my Stock, & the remainder to be divided equally
between my daughters Jane & Margaret, and the my farming implements
shall be for the use of my son James, and my house & farmings shall be
the use of my daughter Elizabeth; It is also my will that my son John
McPeak shall have full liberty to occupy what he can of my house
for the term of two years without interruption & either live in my old
lodge house or have liberty of living in my other little house. I will al-

My long hours belong to my son James and I do hereby constitute and appoint my Trusty friends James Hartt & my son John Swan to be my lawful Executors of this my Last Will & Testament; and I do hereby utterly revoke & disannul all other former wills & legacies given by me before this time named. Ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above written.

"The 13th day of March 1806 I Henry Kerr of the County of Mecklenburg State of N.C. being sick & weak in body but of sound mind & memory thankes be to God for the same, & calling to mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed unto all men once to die, Do make & Ordaine this my last Will & Testament, And principally & first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it, & my body to be buried in a Christian like decent manner, nothing doubting but I shall receive the same again at the righteousnesse of God; And as touching such worldly Estate wherewithal I hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I give & dispose of the same in manner & form following that is to say In the first place I give & bequeath to my son William my tract of land (in order to enable him to discharge all my lawfull debts) for his only proper use & his Heirs & Assigns forever, & negro boy named Stephen my negro woman named Achoda, my bag & bag and all my draperies furniture. — I give to my son & daughter David & Ann Reed my negro girl named Linda and my spinning full — I give & bequeath to my daughter Catherine my negro girl named Maria, my long three years old mare my feather bed & pictures and my Chest. I allow the remainder of my Stock to be equally Divided amongst my three children, It is also my will that all
