 of the County of Kirkcudbright & State of 72^o as above
 being sick & weak of body, of perfect mind & memory
 & calling to mind the uncertainty of life & being desirous
 to make provision of such estate as the Almighty hath
 blessed me with, I do therefore by these presents make
 bind, publish & establish the following as my
 last will & testament at the same time revoking all
 others Viz. 1st My will is that my body be buried
 in a decent Christian manner and all my just debts
 be paid out of my estate 2nd I give & bequeath unto
 my son Hegrick Robison one hundred acres of land
 of the north west end of my plantation wherein I now
 live, to be laid off so as to include his improvements,
 & in such form as may be most convenient for his
 future occupancy 3rd I give & bequeath to my
 beloved wife Elizabeth Robison her Dower in the bottom
 my plantation which is to include the whole of the
 land & improvements wherein I now live, and that
 my family shall have the support of my plantation
 in the same manner as they were accustomed to the
 following provision Viz 4th My will is that my youngest
 son Hegrick Robison shall have & be supported off the
 during his natural life & the whole of my personal
 property to be kept together including my negroes -
 to keep such part as my executors may deem necessary
 to sell at such times as they may think proper for the
 purpose of paying my just debts & such other just demands
 that may come against my estate, & to pay a legacy to
 my daughter Hetty of two hundred & twenty five dollars
 there after named - 5th I give & bequeath to my daughter
Hetty Robison two hundred & twenty five dollars to be
 paid out of my estate as soon as the circumstances of the
 estate will admit 6th My will further is that at the
 death of my wife & the unfortunate son Hegrick
 that the whole of my estate left to her in including
 the real & personal property that may be then on

145 Mind of whom here shall be equally distributed among my surviving children - b I do hereby appoint my son Alexander Robison & my friend William Davidson executors of this my last will & testament given under my hand & seal this 13th day of August 1823

Carolina, being under sickness of body but of sound & disposing mind & memory Do make & ordain my last will & testament in manner and form following Viz T^h my will is that all my just debts be paid - land as to the rest of my property my will is that it be distributed in the following manner Viz To my son Alexander Robison all that piece or parcel of land as laid down on plat filed with this town which his name is written the boundaries of the said land will appear by referring to said plat as the courses are all laid down & the lines all run out & are well known to my son To my son John Robison my bay mare which his has at this time in his possession, also a boar & hogs & I will to my son John Robison all that piece or parcel of land laid down in the aforesaid plat on which his name is written & bounded as described on said Plat To my son William Robison fifty dollars in cash To my daughter Martha Negro her self Sophia my bay m^{are} buck her saddle & bridle & two beds & furniture - To my son Michael Robison the two parcels or pieces of land laid down on the aforesaid plat & his name written on them, also my young sorrel mare called but one two horse place - To my son Willis Robison all that piece or parcel of land designated on said plat as the place on which is written subject to the following uses
