son Hezekiah Robinson shall have & be supported off the
during his natural life & the whole of my personal
property to be kept together including my negroes -
except such part as my executors may deem necessary
to sell at such time as they may think proper for the
purpose of paying my just debts & such other just demands
that may come against my estate, & to pay a legacy to
my daughter Nettie of two hundred & twenty five dollars
thereafter received - 4th I give & bequeath to my daughter
Melroy Robinson two hundred & twenty five dollars to be
paid out of my estate as soon as the circumstances of the
estate will admit. 5th My will further is that at the
death of my wife & the youngest son Hezekiah
that the whole of my estate left to them including
the real & personal property but may in time on

my surviving children - 6th I do hereby appoint my
son Almon Robinson & my friend William Davidson
executors of this my last will & testament -
