North Carolina Mecklenburg County Nov 30th 1795

I being of sound mind & memory & willing to Remembrance
the mortality of my nature & the uncertainty of Life -

Do think it convenient to constitute this my last will
& Testament & by these presents to will & dispose of my

Temporall concerns in the following manner Viz

I give & bequeath my body to the dust to be decently
interred there in at the discretion of my Executors & my

soul into the hands of God who gave it Item I give
& bequeath to my well beloved wife Elizabeth Woods

all my household furniture her spinning wheel one
black horse called black one brown mare called Fil one

large & one small set of plow horses with the plow treading
two pair of new chains & three Tacklings, three Cows

Calves one three year old steer four head of sheep, four
of my best Bees or hogs all the grain & produce belong

ing to the plantation, her riding saddle the chaise
articles to be valued by persons appointed by my execs.

& to be & remain the property of my wife Elizabeth
during her widowhood & in case of her marriage then

the one half of said valuation to be equally divided
between my four children, such articles as are for

immediate family consumption are not to be apprais
ed or valued Item I give & bequeath to my well beloved

son Cyrus all that part of my lands & possessions which
lieth South & South East of a line running from a black

oak corner above my Spring House to a Hickory (now
mine & Richard Kerrs corner - Item I give & bequeath

in my beloved son James all that part of my lands
lying North & North west of said line -

Item I give & bequeath to my brother Levin five or
 five pounds Item It is my will that all the remainder
 of my property be sold & the monies arising therefrom
 after paying all my just debts be equally divided
 between my two beloved daughters Peggy & Rebecka.

Item I do by these presents constitute & appoint Joseph
 & James Henry Executors of this my last will & Testament
 & also to Superintend & direct the running of the law
 dividing my land between my two sons by read &
 James agreeable to the intent & meaning of this my will
 I do also by these presents utterly revoke & disannul
 all & every other will that might have been or might
 be supposed to have been made by me previous to
 the date of these presents - In witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this
 day & year first above written
