If James Stafford being in health & perfect mind & memory calling to mind the Mortality of my body & that it is appointed for all men one to die, I do constitute this my last Will & Testament, and first of all I command my spirit into the hands of God that gave it & my body to be buried in a Christian & decent manner at the discretion of my Heirs & Executors & as touching my worldly Estate, wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me I dispose of in the following manner to wit I give and bequeath unto my son James that tract of Land he now has of purchased by me from Morris Moor & likewise fifty acres lying on the West side of Dobb's line, I also bequeath to my daughter Jane a negro girl named Katie —

I also will I bequeath to my son George all my real and personal Estate he paying my servant Betty — I also constitute & appoint my Sons James Stafford & George Stafford my Executrix to this my last Will & Testament signed sealed & delivered this 21st day of August 1808

I Matthew Smith of Mecklenburg County State of N Carolina being at present weak in body but of a sound disposing mind blessed be God! and calling to mind the Mortality of the body & that it is appointed to all men one to die, I do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following viz
First I recommend my soul to God who gave it

and my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian
like & decent manner at the discretion of my Ex-
ecutor after my death. And as touching such worldly
Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow me with in this
life I give & dispose of as follows - I will that my
just debts & funeral expenses be all paid as soon
as convenient after my decease - I give & bequeath
unto my beloved wife Molly one third of all my
landed possessions including the improvements
also all my live stock except a bolt which I desire
may be kept till the fall of 1814 & then sold & the money
& losses which I will to Delilah Lowry - and further except
one feather bed & its furniture which I will to be given to
the said Delilah Lowry - also I give & bequeath unto my
said wife all my plantation tools & all other moveable
property except two cotton gins & one set of Hoss: works
which I desire to be sold at the discretion of my Executor
also that all my present crop be given to my wife for her
support & the support of the stock except as much corn
& fodder as will feed my Young horse till the first of May
I give & bequeath unto George Chayson son of Elija Chayson
seventy three acres of land being a tract which I lately
bought from Lewis Beard - After my widow's third is sold
off according to law I give & bequeath unto Elija
Chayson all my land from the widow's line northward as
far as the line of the tract which is a tract bequeathed
to his son George - I will that my beloved wife have
full power over all property left to her by this will to
dispose of it in life or at death as she may see fit
except the land - The land I give & bequeath after her death
to Matthew Colvin &ays. or in case of his death to Elijah
&ays. junior - I will that the tract of land which
I lately bought from Benjamin Thompson be sold by my
Executor as soon as convenient after my decease at
their the discretion and the money arising therefrom
with all other monies collected or on hand be used
to pay off all just debts & the remainder of my legacy

to my beloved & affectionate wife for whom I wish all good.
 And further I do hereby nominate & appoint my dear and
 trusty friend Peter Dape Seaver to be the executor of this my
 last will & Testament, And I do hereby Abjure & renounce all
 other & declare this to contain all my will relating to such
 matters as are mentioned therein. In testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 6th day
 of November 1813 In the presence of the witnesses

 to Nancy Higham daughter of William Higham of
 Lincoln County my largest powder Bacon
Item 4th I will to Mary Nelson that now lives with me.
 if she continues to live with me to my pleasure my other
 bed & bedstead & furniture & black mare & one horse that
 she now claims & one new check pillion & one coffee pot
 & tea chaffers in Money & coffee mill & two tin pans & one
