I Matthew Walker of the County of Chesterburg & State of S^c Carolina, being in my ordinary health of body & of a perfect mind & memory & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, I do make & ordain this my last will & testament. And as Touching my worldly goods, whomever it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life, I give & dispose of them in the following manner & form as follows - First of all I call on all my just debts to be paid. Then it is my will & pleasure that my beloved wife Jane shall hold all the ~~plantation~~ ^{plantation} where I now live during her natural lifetime & at her decease it is my desire that my son Matthew shall hold the land for ever. Then it is my desire that my son William shall hold my negro boy named Heard together with a horse named Rock & further it is my will & desire that my son John may have one negro fellow named Richard & likewise two Cows & two heifers. Then it is my will & pleasure that that my son Matthew shall have one negro man named Henry together with one horse with one yearling & likewise my Clock & further it is my desire that my daughter Mary may have after her mothers decease one negro woman named Elizabeth & one father Bock & four blankets & covered to gether with one Cow & calf. Then it is my will & pleasure that my daughter Esty may have one negro woman named Nancy & one big Sorel mare with four Cows & calves & two father Bock & their furniture & likewise two tables & a Bureau with her wheel & cloth & likewise the Loom & the ~~bedding~~ ^{bedding} belonging to her. And further it is my desire that my Grandson James may have one negro woman named Elizabeth & one grey filly three years old & one horse & furniture. And further it is my will & pleasure that my beloved wife Jane shall hold one negro woman

named Rebecca & one little black mare & likewise all the remainder of my property of every kind that hath not already been bequeathed away both house hold & kitchen furniture of every kind, likewise my farming utensils of every kind & all the rest of my property of every kind too tedious to mention, power to do with it as she shall think proper. And it is my desire that my wife shall pay all my debts. And I do hereby constitute & appoint my two sons William & Matthew my sole Executors to this my Last Will & Testament, also annulling all other former Wills, Ratifying this to be my last Will & Testament in Witness whereof the said Matthew Wallander hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal this 26th day of May in the Year of our Lord 1824. - Signed sealed & delivered to be his last Will & Testament in the presence of us who in the presence of each other his Executors affixed our names as witnesses.
