place during her widowhood. Also I give bequeath & devise

is Pecked & one hundred acres unpecked which said land is to be

Equitably divided between them for them their Husbands & signs for ever & custom

 Item. It is my will & desire that the remainder of my estate should be

Hedding, Sarah, Mary Magdaline, Anna Elizabeth, Anne Lucy  
Anna Margaret least of any of these here named should die  
 without having any heirs lawfully begot in wedlock, then such share  
 as shall remain in wife born, shall fall back to the other surviving ones  
 to be equally divided among them, and in unto this my last will & Testament  
 I do make constitute & appoint my beloved friends Bethiaun  
Perry & Samuel Justice as my lawful executors to this my last will  
& Testament, Revoking & disannulling all former wills and  
testaments in writing whereof I have before this present witness
