County in the State of Pennsylvania being mindful of the
frailty & mortality of human nature & that it is appointed for
all men once to die, and considering the uncertainty of the time
& my being weak in body, but in perfect mind memory &
understanding I make this my last will & Testament in man
ner & form following, that is to say first I humbly recommend
my soul unto Almighty God who gave it me & my body to the
earth there to be buried according to the direction of my friends
near & far in faith & certain hope that it will be raised
up to everlasting life at the end of the world thro' the merits of our
Lord Jesus Christ my Redeemer, And as touching my worldly estate
as it has pleased God to bless me with in this life I give, bequeath, devise
& distribute of as here followeth. First I give & bequeath unto my
beloved wife Catherine one third of all my moveable estate & house
her bed, her spinning wheel & a cow & calf likewise her seat on my
place during her widowhood. Then I give bequeath & devise
unto my three sons George, Daniel & John Kline all my land con-
taining in all two hundred & twenty five one hundred & twenty three
& five acres & one hundred acres of land which said land is to be

Equally divided between them for them their heirs & assigns for ever & untom.
 I give & bequeath beside a mass & cell & the gun which I had given
 him some time past Joshua his heir & assigns for ever. — I then I give and
 bequeath unto my two daughters that are single yet, each of them a new
 brass bed, a spinning wheel & a new pot when they come of age or
 should be married for them their heirs & assigns for ever —

Item I give & bequeath unto my good son Michael Lewis son of my
 daughter Catherine when he is married the sum of fifteen pounds good
 money to be paid out of my estate for him & his heirs for ever —

Item It is my will & desire that the remainder of my estate should be
 Equally divided to three my Children here named when they are
 married or come of age namely George, Daniel, John, Christiana,
Hedlira, Barbel, Mary Magdalen, Anna Elizabeth, Anna Mary,
Anna Margaret but if any of these here named should die
 without having any heirs lawfully begot in wedlock then such share
 of estate herein made be shall fall back to the other surviving ones
 to be equally divided amongst them; And unto this my last will &
 Testament I ordain constitute & appoint my beloved friends Bartholomew
Leahy & Samuel Sutter as my Lawful Executors to this my last will
 & Testament, Revoking & disannulling all other former wills and
 Testaments in witness whereof I have before their present witnesses
 I have hereunto set my own hand & seal this first day of December —
 Anno Dom 1784. Signed, Sealed, Proclaimed & Acknowledged
