that is to say primarily & first of all, I give & bequeath my

to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner at the desire
of my executors, nothing doubting but at the general
resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mercy
of God. And as touching such worldly goods & estate which
it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I give devise and
dispos of the same in the manner & form following, that is to say
I give my Negro woman named Ann & her first born son named
will to my daughter Grace wife to James Barrow to hold as full
my daughter's share & if she should or shall die before the boy
shall arrive to the age of twenty one years he shall have
the whole & bequeath to the share of the said boy & should he
be also one of the said children shall come to that age & should he
paying the sum of five hundred pounds to my son Michael Riggall
the said five hundred pounds to my son Jackson Riggall five
hundred & also one hundred to be paid to him by my executors
I also give one hundred pounds to my daughter Esther to be paid by
my executors. And to my son Michael Riggall who I make my
sole & sole executor of this my last will & Testament, I give my
house & all the furniture thereto belonging one bed & furniture one
table, one gun to my son William Riggall. I also give mine all the
money book debts notes bonds &c to him paying the above
sums to my two children Jackson & Esther fully to be paid
at my death. Whatsoever is herein in this my last will &
Testament neglected shall be in the power of him my executor
to do with as shall seem best in his mind to satisfy the same
mentioned - I to hereby collecty disallow

The mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all

that is to say principally first of all, I give & bequeath my
Soul to God who gave all & for my body I bequeath it to the Earth
to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner at the discre-
tion of my executors, nothing doubting but at the general
resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power
of God, And as touching such worldly goods & Estate which with
it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I give devise and
dispose of the same in the manner & form following, that is to say
I give my Negro woman named Puss & her first born son named
Will to my daughter Grace wife to James Harris to have and sell
my daughter Esther & if she should or shall die before she
shall arrive to the age of twenty one years her whole term
& age she & her goods & estate shall come to that of her mother
& also one bed & furniture on loan the above named James Harris
paying the sum of five hundred pounds to my son Richard Liggell
Lithuania five hundred pounds to my son Jackson Liggell, The place
situation I now live on, I give to my son Jackson Liggell with the
boundries & also one hundred to be paid to him by my executors
I also give one hundred pounds to my daughter Esther to be paid by
my executors, And to my son Richard Liggell who I make my
whole & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament, I give my
Wagon saddle & furniture thereto belonging one bed & furniture one
Table, one Gun to my son William Liggell, I also give him all the
Money, Book debts Notes Bonds & to him paying the above
sums to my two children Jackson & Esther freely to be paid
and enjoyed, whatsoever is herein in this my last Will &
Testament neglected shall be in the power of him my Executor
to do with as shall seem best in his mind to satisfy the several
parties above mentioned - I do hereby utterly disallow
revoke & disannul all & every the former Testaments Wills &
Legacies, Bequests & Executors by me in any wise before this time
made & bequeathed, Notifying & confirming this to
be my last Will & Testament, In witness whereof
