pounds after the death of my said son Fenton is seven years past age
and not till they are married bearing interest from the time
they are of age, 5th It is my will & desire that Henry & my
wife's son shall have one horse & saddle value at twenty pounds
if he stays until he be of age, & 6th It is my will that sundry
good causes moving me heretofore the said Craig, Jane Wargate
Mannah Craig Elizabeth, Isabella John Craig, Mary Craig
& Nancy Craig shall have five shillings each. 7th & lastly I do
hereby nominate constitute & appoint my friend Samuel Gaudin
my loving wife Isabella Craig & Andrew Oles my Executors
of this my last will & Testament, hereby I remove all others
& make void all wills, gifts, grants, legacies & bequests, what
soever heretofore by me made or done, Ratifying & confirming
this to be my last will & Testament in witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & seal the 12th day of March AD 1796

of this my last will & Testament, hereby I remove all others
& make void all wills, gifts, grants, legacies & bequests, what
soever heretofore by me made or done, Ratifying & confirming

named Sarah Price the whole of my Stock of every kind to
go therewith all utensils for farming belonging to the plan-
tation or in any manner belonging to my Estate & likewise
my bed & furniture with the whole of my wearing apparel
Lastly I do make & constitute James Morrison & Sarah
Price Executors of this my last will & Testament, Ratifi-
ying & confirming this & no other as my last will
and Testament dated this 11th day of January in
the year of our Lord 1803.
