In the name of God Amen. This 10th day of December 1818 I Harry
Hagan of New Hanover County State of North Carolina, being sick & in
a low condition but of perfect mind & memory calling to mind the
mortality of my body & knowing it is appointed for all men once
to die, do make & declare in this my last Will & Testament in the following
manner & form, I give & recommend my soul unto the hands of God
that gave it, and my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian
like & decent manner at the discretion of my executors nothing
doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same
again by the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly goods
wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me hitherto in this life I give
and dispose of the same in the following manner & form -
Inasmuch as my will & do order in the first place that all my just
debts & funeral charges be paid & satisfied. Then, As my will & do
order that the Land I now live on with two horses & my farmey
implements & all my house hold furniture with all my stock of
cattle & hogs, also as much money as will make my dwelling house
comfortable to him to be in the use of my dear, belov'd wife & that
she use during her life inboard. I also give & bequeath unto her my
gold Watch & one hundred dollars to dispose of as she pleases. Then I
give & bequeath unto my married daughter Elizajay wife to John B.
Brake a grey York called Hitty a Horse & saddle with all the furniture
I put into his hand after her marriage to be hers, her share & part
out of my whole estate. Then, as it is will & do order all the money
arising out of or from my estate & the unwillins property belonging
to the same to be divided into Eleoween equal shares, one of which
I allow to my wife & am share to each of my children (my slaves)

Mayes or excepted) Viz One Share to my daughter Jenny, one share
to Cynthia & to my son Abraham one share, & to my daughter Matilda
one share & to my son Moses one share, To my son John one share
& to my Daughter Patsy Plaza one share, and one share to my son
William one share, and the other two shares to be appropriated to the
Paying & education of my young children particularly my sons &
of any of my sons appears to have a good genius or turn of mind
or learning I allow my executors to aid & assist them as far as the
two shares apportioned ~~that~~ way holds out, and in case none of
them are desirous of a liberal Education, the balance of the two
shares remains after making them good English scholars, & allows
it to be equally divided among my sons when the youngest son
comes at the age of Twenty one years of age, my land also at the
marriage or death of my wife to be equally divided among my
sons but not till the youngest becomes Twenty one years of age
only one hundred dollars of the price of my land or of the profits arising
from the same, I allow to be at the disposal of my wife 450 dollars
I give to my sister Elizabeth Hayes if single when the land is sold—
& I do hereby appoint constable & claim my husband wife brothers
& sister & my brother & brother John Hayes & John Mr executors of this
my last will & Testament, unto I do hereby wholly revoke all allowed
written all former Testaments Wills Legacies & bequests by me in
my wife may, Ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my
last will & Testament. Signed. Sealed, published pronounced and
declared by the said Charles Hayes as his last will & Testament
in the presence of us who in his presence & in the presence of each
other have hereunto set our hands as corroborating witnesses
