 cloths & if said Thomas Seaton comes & demands P. money
 he is to be paid according to the valuation of the ^{currency} ~~money~~
 at this date, And John Mulligan I bequeath to my beloved
 friend Baptist Mulligan all my out lying debts & debts
 due me the full power to receive & collect the same with
 all cloathing book & book cloathing etc. now held in trust
 that belongs to me that is now in his house. Lastly I
 do appoint & authorize John Mulligan as my lawful
 executor of this my last will & testament, & do revoke
 disannul all other will & wills Legacies & bequests in
 acknowledge this as my last will & testament this 16th
 day of September in the year of our Lord 1779
 signed, sealed, published pronounced by the said
Jane Seaton as her last will & testament in presence

In the name of God Amen, I Moses Shelby of the County
 of Franklin in the State of K. C. Va. being thro'
 the abundant mercy & goodness of God through which in body
 yet of a sound understanding & memory. Do constitute this
 my last will & testament & desire it may be received by
 all as such. First I most humbly beseech my dear
 God my maker beseeching his most gracious accep-
 -tance of it thro' the all sufficient merits & mediation of
 my most compassionate Redeemer Jesus Christ
 as for my body I recommend it to the earth to be
 buried without pomp or state at the discretion of
 my Executors hereafter named; who I doubt not

will manage it with all requisite prudence, such as
 to my worldly Estate I will & positively Order that all
 my debts be paid. I give to my dear & beloved
 wife during her widowhood this house together with
 some five together with all the furniture & the same
 & ornaments that I use about it except such furniture
 as here after is mentioned. Also I give to my loving wife
 five work creatures & eight Milk Cows & Calves -
 together with two plows & Tacklings & all my pla-
 nation tools for the benefit of my wife & her young
 children. Item I will & bequeath to my beloved sons
William Shelby & John Shelby the plantation I now
 live upon together with two attendances joining
 the original survey as said deeds will testify upon
 partition to be equally divided between said
 William & John Shelby at the discretion of my
 Executors & to resort to said William & John Shelby
 or ~~the survivor~~ one at the age of Twenty one years
 but if both should die under that age I Order the
 whole to be sold & equally divided amongst my dear
 living & beloved Item I will & bequeath to my dear
 beloved son Esau Shelby that plantation on Caldwell
 creek which I bought from Patrick Gibson together
 with the wagon & Team he has now in possession
 also a negro boy named Viles. Item I will & bequeath
 to my beloved son Thomas Shelby that plantation
 known by the name of the poplar Spring place to be
 separated from the plantation I now live upon in
 the following manner. The line to begin near Oliver
 Nyles run & to go behest two Springs near the mouth
 of Shelleys branch from thence to a poplar known by
 Oliver Nyles from thence to a large black oak well
 known by said Nyles & from the point or money
 corner in the public survey by way of by Esau &
 Thomas Shelby equally they are to be in equal cost
 of purchasing a negro lad which Negro I will to
 my beloved son Thomas Shelby also I will & bequeath
