of body but of sound mind & memory, calling to mind my last
affe writing dispositions, Do make & ordain this as my last will
& Testament, and first I give my soul to God who gave it to
my body to the Earth, And as touching such worldly estate as
God hath given me I give & dispose of in the following manner
viz I Will give & bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife Mary
one half of all my Estate both real & personal if it appear to my
executors hereafter named that the said half is not sufficient to
support my said wife thru' the remainder of her living
life; that then & in that case I will & bequeath to her the said Mary
the two thirds of all my said Estate, & further that my said beloved
wife Mary should stand suffer or become a burthen to any
said two thirds not being sufficient to support her, then in that
case order will & bequeath to her my said wife Mary the three
fourths of all my said Estate, and the privilege of living on &
enjoying the benefit of my land as long as my said Executrix
judges fit for her & the Childrens beds & lages making them
thereon within sum of £13 4—

I will give & bequeath unto my beloved children Joseph Flinn
William Flinn, Andrew Flinn, Elizabeth Flinn, Rebecca Flinn
& Jane Flinn the residue & remainder of all my said Estate
that is the one half, the one third, or the one fourth according as the case
may be to be equally divided among them, & if in order that ample
justice may be done my wife & husband I will give her with the
expenses coming & due over unto my trusty & honest neighbors
William Henderson, James Henry Michael Henderson, Andrew
Henderson & John McNeill Anderson all my lands & tenements
that I have held since my marriage to the same persons & of whom

in Trust now & thereafter that they, the said William Henderson
James Henry, Michael & Andrew Henderson & John McAllister
or any of them who may be acting Executrix do here after witness
the same & more for the Advantage of my said wife & children
to sell & convey said lands for the best price they can get & after
the manner herein ensuing to dispose of as above directed.

And first I nominate & appoint the said William Henderson
James Henry, Michael Henderson, Andrew Henderson & John Mc
Allister to be my whole & sole Executrix of this my last Will
& Testament requesting them to sell immediately after my death
such part of my Goods & Chattels as they please or think proper
leaving remaining all other lands, Gifts or bequests, confirming
this & no other as my last Will & Testament, in Writing whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 20th day of August 1785
Signed sealed published pronounced & declared by the said
Nicholas Stein as his last will & Testament who in his
presence & in the presence of each other subscribed our names
