Thomas B Smith Executors to this my last will & Testament

In the name of God Amen. I Nicholas Kropp of the County of  
Mecklenburg & State of North Carolina being very sick & weak of  
body & of perfect mind & memory thanks be given to God, calling  
to mind the mortality of my body, do make & ordain this my last  
will & Testament in manner following: I command my  
soul into the hands of Almighty God that gives it, and my  
body I command to the earth to be buried in decent Christian  
burial at the discretion of my executors, and as touching my  
temporally Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with  
in this life. I give devise & dispose of the same in the following  
manner & form -

on Third part of all my marrable estate to gother with the best house  
on my plantation & her Saddle & bridle also the two best cows  
on my plantation & my Table two Pewter Dishes & six Pewter plates &  
six Spoons & my Bed, bedstead & furniture & the best room in my  
house as long as she keeps my Name, and has spending wher to  
Reed & the best place in the Garden & one Negro or Indian thousand  
pounds lawful Money which is due to me from Absalom Baker  
& my stepson & the Slave to keep in the House & the Stell & especially  
to be hers as long as she keeps my Name.

And also I give to my beloved Son Philip Krebs one Tract of Land  
Deed containing one hundred & twenty acres more or less with  
the improvements he has made thereon joining & between Decid  
Springs & Philip Wolfs land & my son Philip is to give fifteen or  
Twenty acres of his said Land from said Wolfs corner to Krebs line  
Eighty line & my son Philip is to give my younger son Jacob  
Fifty pounds in Gold or Silver at the time that Jacob comes of age  
free of Interest till that time & also I give to my son Philip  
one bay horse & saddle & bridle & Rifle gun that he now claims  
also one ox & Mallet & Mould rings & wedges and he is to give said  
fifteen or Twenty acres of Land to Tobias

And also I give & bequeath to my beloved son Tobias the plantation  
whereon I now dwelle & Tobias is to give Philip Twenty five acres  
of Land it being part of an entry & Tobias is to give him added  
part of his said entry lying on this west side of Buffalo Creek joining  
Krebs line, and also my son Tobias is to give his mother every  
year fifteen bushels of wheat & to sow one quarter of an acre  
of flax where ever she chooses it on said plantation, & my  
son Tobias is to maintain his mother as long as she remains  
a widow & to pay one hundred pounds lawful Money of this  
State Fifty, of which to Henry in Gold or Silver when he  
comes of age free of Interest till that time & the other fifty  
pounds he is to pay to my daughter Lucy nine in Gold or  
Silver five

bound Lawfull Money which is due to me from Abielom Baker  
of my draper & the Stove to keep in the House & the Still & vessels  
to be here as long as she keeps my name -  
And also I give to my beloved Son Philip Krebs one Tract of Land  
Deeds containing one hundred & twenty acres more or less with  
the improvements he has made thereon joining & between said  
tracts & Philip Wolfs land & my son Philip is to give fifteen or  
Twenty acres of his said land from said Wolfs corner to Creek line  
Weight line & my son Philip is to give my younger son Jacob -  
Fifty pounds in Gold or Silver at the time that Jacob comes of age  
clear of Interest till that time & also I give to my son Philip  
one bay horse & saddle & bridle & rifle gun that he now claims  
also one ox & Mallett March rings & wedges and he is to give said  
fifteen or Twenty acres of Land to Tobias  
And also I give & bequeath to my beloved son Tobias the plantation  
whereon I now dwelle & Tobias is to give Philip Twenty five acres

nut of his dead lying on this west side of Buffalo Creek joining  
Creek line, and also my son Tobias is to give his mother every  
year fifteen bushels of Wheat & to sow one quarter of an acre  
of Flax where ever she chooses it on said plantation, & my  
son Tobias is to maintain his mother as long as she remains  
a widow & to pay one hundred pounds Lawfull Money of this  
State Fifty of which to Henry in Gold or Silver when he  
comes of age clear of Interest till that time & the other fifty  
pounds he is to pay to my Daughter by name in Gold or  
Silver five years after my decess clear of Interest till that  
time, and also I give to my son Tobias my Still & vessels  
after his mothers decease or before her name, and Tobias is to  
give his mother one hundred weight of Pork & by weight of  
Beef every year as long as she lives by my name -  
And I also give & bequeath to my son Henry all my Tools belong  
ing to my trade if he chooses to learn the trade, But if he chooses

to have the South tract my Dole shall be divided amongst  
all my Sons & Henry shall have one Entry of Land containing  
one hundred acres bearing the name Christian & Sonshines  
& my own Land laid & taken Mowers land, land also I give to  
my son Jacob his Ben. Gray horse that he now claims & also I give  
Tobias my Waggon & Horses & the I gave to my son Henry & my  
son Jacob each a horse to be furnished to them by Tobias when  
they come of age which said Horse is to be valued at fifteen pounds  
each lawful Money & Tobias is to have one Sord Horse that is now  
on my plantations down by the Mc Hatch Marsh rings & wedges  
& my brogs and saw & fro further use of all my Sons & also I give  
to my two Sons Henry & Jacob an ox & Mc Hatch Marsh rings &  
wedges & also my log chain amongst all my Sons -  
Also I give to my beloved Daughters Catherine, Elizabeth, Deborah  
& Malley & chargeable to which I give unto each of those a Spinning  
wheel and leather bid & furniture thereunto, and all the rest  
of my Estate I give to my two youngest Sons Henry & Jacob  
and all my Daughters, to be equally divided amongst them  
And I do likewise constitute & appoint make and bid Jacob  
Jacob Misinkimer & Joseph Shinn the sole Executrix of this  
my last Will & Testament, And I do Authorize & empower  
them my Executrix to make Deeds to the Lands as before  
mentioned to my Sons and also hereby utterly disallow &  
dislike all former Wills, Legacies & Executors  
ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will &  
Testament I witnesseth whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
& seal this 17<sup>th</sup> day of October 1788.
