sale the residue of my Effects not withheld in order to enable

to my nephew Thomas Johnston. And I do hereby
appoint & ordain David McDonald sole Executor of this my
last Will & Testament. which I now sign seal publish
& declare in the presence of August 13th 1816

In the name of God Amen. I Petitioner Jones of the State of So
Carolina Charleston County, on account of tender weakness
being at present much afflicted with the pain & weakness
of a second discharging mind blessed be God, finding I can
not long remain in the body Do make & ordain this my
last Will & Testament in manner & form following
I God those given of my life, receiving my departing soul into
my hands I commend my spirit to him. My body is from
the earth & must return to the same. It is therefore my last
will that it be buried in a Christian like & decent manner at
the direction of my Executors to be named hereinafter
And as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to
bless me with, I give & dispose of the same as follows
First I will that all my Just debts & funeral expenses be paid
as soon as convenient after my decease; Secondly I will & bequeath
to each & all of my children whatever I have at any time
given to any or all of them previous to my decease, And that
no demands be made on any of them for debts which may be
supposed due to me. Thirdly I give & bequeath to each of my
hereinafter named one dollar - John Jones, James Jones, Thomas
Jones, Jordan Jones, & Mary Jones, Patsy Thompson, Sally Peterson
Lois Thompson, Chas. Rogers & Elizabeth Thompson. And

with this reserve that they will not be entitled to it only upon
demanding it in their own persons. Fourth I give & bequeath
my feather bed in which I usually sleep & its furniture inclu-
ding the bedstead to Lucy Jones oldest daughter of my son
David. & Fifth I give & bequeath all that remains of my
property whither out of Doors or within the same together
with the money in hand & out standing debts & all my clothing
&c &c To my Daughter Nancy to be her own service -
And further I do nominate & appoint my son David & my Daughter
Nancy Executors & Executrix of this my last will & Testament, hereby
revoking all former wills by me heretofore made, Ratifying &
confirming this to be my real & true last will & Testament
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my seal this 13th September 1820

but not in sound mind & memory & calling to mind the uncertainty
of life, Do make this my last will & Testament in manner & form

after the following manner. 1st It is my will & pleasure that
all my Land, Horse Saddle & Tridle & the rest of my property shall
return to my father Lewis Setton Except so far as shall be here
after mentioned. I leave & bequeath to my Mother one negro
boy named Melas. Also I leave & bequeath to my brother
David Setton my best suit of clothes, the rest of my clothes
to be disposed at my Mother's discretion allowing my beloved
father to be my whole & sole executor of this my last will
& Testament, hereunto I have set my hand & seal this 18th
