

In the name of God Amen. I Petitioner James of the State of
 Carolina & Charleston County, on the line of Twelve mile creek,
 being at present much afflicted with the pain & weakness
 of a sound disposing mind blessed be God, finding I can
 not long remain in the body Do make & declare this my
 last Will & Testament in manner & form following
 I Give those given of my life, leaving my departing soul into
 my hands I commit my spirit Amen. My body is from
 the earth & must return to the same. It is therefore my will
 that it be buried in a Christian like & decent manner at
 the discretion of my Executors to be named hereinafter
 And as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to
 bless me with, I give & dispose of the same as follows
 First I will that all my Just debts & funeral expenses be paid
 as soon as convenient after my decease; Secondly I will & bequeath
 to each & all of my children whatsoever I have at any time
 given to any or all of them previous to my decease, and that
 no demands be made on any of them for debts which may be
 supposed due to me. Thirdly I give & bequeath to each of my
 heirs after named one dollar - John Jones, James Jones, Thomas
 Jones, Jordan Jones, & Man Jones, Paddy Thompson, Sally Peterson
 Lois Thompson, Chassey Rogers & Elizabeth Thompson and

with this reserve that they will not be entitled to it only upon
 demanding it in their own persons - Fourth I give & bequeath
 my feather bed in which I usually sleep & its furniture includ-
 ing the bedstead to Lucy Jones oldest daughter of my son
 David. & Fifth I give & bequeath all that remains of my son
 property whether out of Doors or within the same together
 with the money in hand & out standing debts & all my clothing
 &c &c To my Daughter Nancy to be her own service -
 And further I do nominate & Appoint my son Shered & my Daughter
 Nancy Executor & Executrix of this my last will & Testament, hereby
 making all former wills by me heretofore made, (Ratifying &
 confirming this to be my real & true last will & Testament
 in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
 my seal this 13th September 1820

 County, I Ezekiel Jettom now being in a low condition in which
 but not in sound mind & memory & calling to mind the uncertainty
 of life, Do make this my last will & Testament in manner & form
 first His my will & pleasure that all my property shall be disposed
 after the following manner - 1st It is my will & pleasure that
 all my Land, Horse saddle & trills & the rest of my property shall
 return to my father Lewis Jettom Except so far shall be here
 after mentioned. I leave & bequeath to my Mother one negro
 boy named Melas - Also I leave & bequeath to my brother
 Isaac Jettom my best sort of clothes, the rest of my clothes
 to be disposed at my Mothers discretion Allowing my beloved
 father to be my whole & sole Executor of this my last will
 & Testament, hereunto I have set my hand & seal this 18th
