

Perry & Simeon Luther as my lawful executors to this my last will
& Testament, Devolving & disseminating all other former wills and
Testaments in writing whereof I have before these present witnesses
I have heretofore set my hand & seal this first day of December

In the name of God Amen. I Peter Hines of the State of New Hampshire
& County of Rockingham, Gardiner, being for some time failing in
body & finding myself still on the declining hand, and as it hath pleased
an all wise God to bless with a numerous family & a little of the good
things of this life & finding myself of a sound disposing mind & memory
thereforee to make this my last will & Testament & first recommend
my soul to Almighty God who gave it begining he woulde be graciously
pleased to accept the same for the merit sake of the ever blessed Jesus
in whom I desire to trust, and with respect to my worldly affairs I
call upon all my just & lawfull debts to be paid
Imprimis. I bequeath unto my wife Fanny Hines the one third of

all my moveable estate together with a bed & furniture. Then opening
b-hall his bearing of each & a little land near the mouth of the stile
house branch where it runs into the river Upton rock from the said end
of the branch up said branch, thereunto rods dimensions peeing
forty rods of said river till two acres are completed. Leaching house
barn & Richard H. to have the one third of all the rest of the premises
of the plantation to be held & enjoyed by him in fee simple for no longer than a
Baldwin & my big wife during her widow hood.

I. I will & declare that my mill on rocky river & the land adja-
ng said mill be sold in six months after my decease & all my other
moveable estate to be put to publick sale as well as the above named
mill & at the death or marriage of having my wife & brother and
brother in my son to pay the publication expenses up at the
Court to publick sale & what ever it is sold for I allow it to be
divided in the following manner that is to say I allow or bid
that all of the moveable estate & the price of the mill. I order
that it be divided in eight equal shares between my loving sons

this to be my only last will & Testament signed with my hand
& sealed with my seal & dated this 5th day of April in the year of our Lord
