this my Last Will & Testament—In Witness whereof

appointed unto all men once to die, I make & ordain this
my last Will & Testament in manner & form following viz

 at the celebration of my sacred sacrament I therefore
 to such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me
 with, I desire that all my Just debts & funeral expenses
 be paid as soon as convenient after my decease
 Third I give & bequeath unto my belov'd wife Elizabeth
 the house hold & kitchen furniture with the lease & covenants
 the hogs that are on hand & sheep & poultry, one day my
 call loan with tools sufficient for farming by my will
 I wish my wife Elizabeth to move back to the house we
 moved from & that tract of Land to hold during her life, I
 hereby confirm unto Elizabeth my wife all as before to be
 for her use & to be disposed of at her discretion except
 the Land during her life & what property remains at her
 death to be sold & divided equally among all my children
 Fourth I give & bequeath unto my son Washington
 Jackson the balance of that of Land I bought of Lewis
 Board also the tract of Land on which his mother is to
 live after her decease shall be given to him
 Fifth I give & bequeath unto my son Peter Marwin De la
 the land I bought of Benjamin Thompson which we
 now live Sixth I will that the tract of Land I bought
 of William Pope be sold with the remaining part of my
 property as soon as convenient after my decease I do
 hereby authorize my Executor to make a good & lawful
 deed of sale for this same as much as could be sold
 when, & further I do hereby nominate & appoint William
Pope the Executor of this my last will & Testament & I do
 hereby disavow all former wills by me heretofore made
 & declare this to last will & Testament for testimony
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal
 this 31st day of January 1882
