whereunto it has pleased God to blese me in this life
I give likewise & dispose of the same in the following -
manner & form; First, I give Twenty shillings to the
poor & likewise I give & bequeath to my my dear
belov'd wife the negro boy & the hatter, my estate to be
sold & divided out together with all my household goods
Debts & Land & moveable effects only kept in observed
to himself. Also I give to my well belov'd Son Nathaniel
Needlesall all my living brother; Also I give to my
well belov'd Daughter Elizabeth Needlesall the half
of all my Estate, And likewise I constitute make
declare Mary Needlesall my sole Executrix of the
