Do make & ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & form following. Viz. It is my will & desire after my decease that my herein after named Executors sell what possible & able property I may be possessed of on the date of my decease & the money arising therefrom together with what debts are then due me be first appropriated to the payment of my just debts & the balance if any be put out to Interest for the benefit of my herein after named Children to be given them as they marry or arrive of age. It is my will & desire that my negro man Harry be hired out by my Executor from year to year to some good Master & the monies arising therefrom to be put out to Interest from year to year till my youngest child becomes of age or marries, then all the said monies with the valuation of my negro man Harry to be equally divided between my four Children viz John, Caroline, Nichols & Henry 3rd. It is my will & desire that my before named Children be

Bound out by the Court so that the boys learned
some good trade & them & the girls have common
schooling - Herin cancelling & revoking all former
wills whatever date - In the traps whereof I have
made my mark in the presence of their subscribing
Witnesses - 4th I bequeint my friend Paris Alexander
Executor to this my last will & Testament
