Nancy Strong Ten dollars and one bed with
its furniture (up (stares)) I give and bequeath
to her son John ~~Hance~~ Strong Ten dollars I give
and bequeath to my nephew ~~John Hance~~
Sixty dollars I give and bequeath to my nephew

to the daughters of Mr. Nancy Strong and their

furniture except that already given and all

various or supplying the wants of those that
