20 In the name of God Amen. I Rachel McKim of the County of
Chatham & State of Carolina, being in a low state of health
but of sound mind & memory thanks to God for the same & calling
to mind the mortality of my body, knowing that it is appointed
unto men once to die, I do make & publish this my last will & testament in the manner & form following Vizth I commit my soul
into the hands of God who created it, & my body to be buried in a
decent Christian like manner - say all my debts -

2^d I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Wilson my Negro
woman Phillis formerly given her with what she has received
from me heretofore, also Nick the third child of my Negro woman
Betty I give & bequeath unto her - 3^d I give & bequeath unto my
eldest son Samuel McKim my Negro man Simon with what she
has I mean & have given unto him heretofore, also Polina the fifth child
of my Negro woman Peggy I give & bequeath unto him & my margin
Belle 4th I give & bequeath unto my son Joseph McKim my Negro
woman Peggy with all her children (except Polina) namely Liza
Cynthia, Billy, Hanson & Harriet also one half of my beds & their fur-
niture & whatever formerly given I give & bequeath unto him -

5th I give & bequeath unto my son Stephen McKim the balance
of my property namely Betty my old Negro woman Katey & all her
children (except Nick) viz Caroline, Evaline, Jack & Hannah
also Sylvia & her child China; two half of my beds & their furniture, but
board & kitchen furniture & what ever else may be considered mine
in the House or about it - And I hereby disannul all other Wills
by me heretofore made And do hereby constitute & appoint my
three sons Samuel, Joseph & Stephen & my son in law John Wilson
my Executors of this my last Will & Testament. And have here-
set my hand & seal this 5th September 1822 -
