

In the name of God Amen, I Rebecca Williamson
of Northampton County New Brunswick in firm and body
but of sound mind Do make this my last will & testament
in manner & form as follows viz -

- 1st I Will that all my last debts be paid.
- 2^d I Will to my beloved nephews Frederick Williamson and if
it be legal for me to do so two negroes named Abner and
Amenda on the provision that they pay to the Legation of
my father in person one of his last will & testament
the sum of one hundred & twenty dollars, and that he
the said Frederick Williamson treat these negroes humanely
- 3^d I Will that my personal effects be carefully gathered, and
that to gather with my stock of every description my
Household & Kitchen furniture, books & ornaments, upper
farming utensils & whatever other property I possess
be exposed to public sale and from the proceeds, I Will that
my negro boy named Bob have thirty dollars in Cash
for the purpose of paying his own debts & is a remuneration
for his services to me; I likewise Will to my negro girl
named Secretia pin clothes & apparel with ten shillings -
- 4th I Will to my beloved brother James Williamson living
in Tennessee the remainder of my Estate -
- 5th I Will & appoint James and John Hamilton McNeill
executors of this my last will & testament. In witness
whereof I set my hand & seal this 26th day of August
1832. Signed sealed & attested
