In the name of God Amen I Jesse Price of the County & State aforesaid being for behoove in life & death in body tho' sound in mind calling to recollection the mortality of my body & that it is appointed for all men once to die, I commit my soul to almighty God who gave it, & my body to the debt to be incurred at the discretion of my Executors hereafter appointed, and concerning my worldly property I dispose of it in the following manner viz First I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Price the plantation I now live on containing three hundred acres to be hers & her heirs forever, also I order & it is my will that my said beloved wife Sarah in case the following negroes, to wit, Joe, Martha, Frank being man & also with Neeth,anny & Mary & her four children viz Ephraim, Mary, Lucy & William also I order & it is my will that my old negro woman Nancy & a young negro woman which is an indentured servant be maintained by my plantation during their natural life - Second I do order & it is my will that my three negroes viz Adam, Peter & Thomas be hired out yearly during their natural life by my Executors hereafter appointed & the money arising from hire to be paid yearly as it becomes due to my said Executors & if three or four of them go to the use of the Presbyterian Church & support of the Gospel of Jesus Christ my Executors to see the money disposed of as above directed - Third also in addition to the before mentioned bequest I give

I bequeath to my said beloved wife Sarah Price, for her life & her heirs  
which is all my stock, with all my black cattle sheep & Hogs & also  
my Household & Kitchen furniture every part & parcel thereof to be  
hers & her heirs forever &c. — I do hereby constitute & appoint  
my dearly beloved wife Sarah & my Trusty Neighbours & Friends  
Elijah Harris & John Harris Executors to execute this my last will  
& Testament, hereby revoking & annulling & making void all  
former Wills & Testaments by me made, testifying this & none  
else to be my last will & Testament, In Witness whereof I have  
set my hand & Seal the above date.

of four years It is my will that my daughter Mary McConkie  
shall have the full & portion of the same half of my land  
with interest thereon & she to live on the same forever — & I  
do will to my daughter Mary's daughter Mary & to my

to the time she shall get the same at eighteen years of age out of  
my estate, and lastly I do will & declare I do appoint my son  
Joseph McConkie & Robert Newman Executors of this my last will
