with one hundred & fifty dollars due me by my brother
in law Matthew shall be after all my just debts is
paid, be equally divided between my three sisters viz
Henry Parks wife of Robert Parks, Sophia Black
wife of James Black & Jane Madolington wife of
Joseph Madolington Item I will & bequeath to my
sister Peggy Madlone wife of Nathaniel Madlone five dollars
Item I will & bequeath to my niece Keriza Madlone
Twenty five Dollars — Item It is also my will
that my interest in a piece of Land lying in the
County of left myself & sisters by the last
will of my Father Joseph Young, which is to be sold
at the death of my Mother, be Equally divided
between my three aforesaid Sisters Henry Parks
Sophia Black & Jane Madolington — Item It is my
will that my notes, or accounts that may be on hands
at my death be equally divided between my
three aforesaid Sisters Henry, Sophia & Jane. And Lastly
I do nominate & appoint my Brother in law John & Park,
my executor to execute this my last will & Testament, Discharging
& confirming this & disannulling all others, In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal

& appoint this my last Will & Testament. And I desire

And first I give & recommend my soul into the hands

but at the last day I shall receive the same at the
great day of Resurrection by the almighty power
of God who fashioned & made man in my Mother womb
& mercifully supported & fed me forth comfortable
thou carried me as on Eagles Wings over Mountains
of difficulties & made me very sensible that it was
good for me to be afflicted, and now thank God
for all his mercies & pray for wisdom & prescience
of mind to set my house in order & settle the affairs
thereof with discretion unto the end by the grace of
God whose most glorious name be praised forever
unto world with end human. And my body I recommend
to the dust from whence it came to be buried in a
Christian like manner (not in pomp or state) all the
