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In the name of God Amen. I Richard Robinson of
County of Mecklenburg & State of N^c Carolina, being under
sickness of body but of sound & disposing mind & memory
Do make & ordain my last will & testament in manner and
form following viz 1st my will is that all my just debts
be paid - And as to the rest of my property my will is
that it be distributed in the following manner viz
To my son Almon Robinson all that piece or parcel
of land as laid down on plat filed with this Court which
his name is written the boundaries of the said land will
appear by referring to said plat as the courses are all tied
down & the lines all run out & are well known to my son
To my son John Robinson my bay mare which he has at
this time in his possession, also a cow & calf & I will
to my son John Robinson all that piece or parcel of
land laid down in the aforesaid plat on which his
name is written & bounded as described on said Plat
To my son William Robinson fifty dollars in Cash
To my daughter Matthea Negro Girl Sophia my bay mare
with her saddle & bridle & two beds & furniture -
To my son Richard Robinson the two parcels or pieces of land
as laid down on the aforesaid plat & his name written on
them, also my young Saddle mare called bet & one two
horse plow - To my son Willis Robinson all that piece
or parcel of Land designated on said plat as the old piece
& on which is written subject to the following mess
- beaver viz. my two unmarried daughters are to have one
this part of my plantation viz the mansion house
may be or on

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while they can struggle. Also to my said son Walter my
young house for any one here please. To my daughter
Lyttie my negro girl named my young man Mobee
two hundred & fifty dollars in cash. To my
Daughter Lucy my negro girl named Liza my old man
money & her ~~husband~~ George and her two hundred & fifty dollars
also my house and for the comfortable maintenance
of my family living with me or remaining on the place
after my decease, I will that one hundred & fifty bushels
of corn all the flour & bacon on hand & the way & fodder
& the stock of coffee & sugar on hand I allow them things
to remain for the comfortable maintenance of my family
I allow my negro man named Jack to remain on the
farm three years for the support of my two unmarried
Daughters & then to be sold & equally divided among
my children, And the remainder of my property not
willed above I direct to be sold at public vendue &
after my debts are paid whatever remains of my estate
my will is that it be equally divided among all my
children; And in the last place I appoint my son
John Robison & Michael Robison my son in law
William Ch' Coy Executors of this my last will and
Testament, & by these presents revoke & make void all
other wills & Testaments by me heretofore & declare
this alone to be my last will & Testament. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my
seal this the 17th of February 1827 -
