hope of a glorious Resurrection in union with my body at  
the last day - And next I will & begin with that all my lawfull  
debts shall be paid; Next I will & begin with to my brother Mr.  
Brown & David Brown all my land goods & chattels together with  
Habys Bonds & book debts equally to be divided at the discre-  
tion of my executors here after mentioned excepting one  
white filly which I will & begin with to my sister Margaret  
Neil I will & begin with to Sister Elizabeth Twenty shillings  
Next I will & begin with to my brother Nathew one hundred  
Pounds I will & begin with to my brother all the interest arising  
from notes & bonds during his life; And further I appoynt  
James Apelman my executors of this my last will & testament  
I do recollect & remeber all other wills or testaments heretofore  
made by wills or writing of these here with set by my hand & seal  
the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 1745 - signed sealed & delivered in
