one Marn a bay below likewise all my stock of cattle now in
my possession likewise all my household furniture also my bed
& furniture thereon to my well beloved Hannah Rogers I leave
one Doller also her bed & furniture unto her specially --
Item To my well beloved Daughter Iren I leave one Doller ther about
Item To my late beloved Daughter Anne Brown I leave one Doller &
her bedding ther bed & furniture and her saddle --
Item To my well beloved Daughter Catharine I leave one Doller
and her bed & furniture ther saddle -- Item to my well beloved
Daughter Mary Brown now Mary Marwell I leave one Doller
Item I leave to my youngest beloved daughter Catharine and Dethard
her bedding ther bed & furniture -- Item to my well beloved
Daughter Susanna I leave one Doller & her bedding --
Item To my well beloved Son Richard I leave my plantation I now
live on only my wife to have her living out of it as above mentioned
also my waggon & gear to be put to his use also my Riffle gun --
Given under my hand & seal the 26th day of February 1769
