

In the Name of God Amen, I Robert Buchanan of County of Mecklenburg & State of N^o Carolina, being weak in body but of sound & perfect mind & memory thanks in to God, in it calling to mind the mortality of my body, do make & make like this my last will & Testament in manner & form as follows That is to say first, That all my several charges be & are lawfully discharged & paid out of my estate, Secondly I give & bequeath the wife my beloved wife Nancy Buchanan her last & full... Cupboard & Chinese furniture & her maintenance of the improvements her life time; Thirdly I do also give & bequeath unto my oldest son Charles Buchanan the sum of one Dollar to be paid to him out of the several... property; Fourthly I do also give & bequeath unto my son Edward Buchanan the sum of ten dollars to be paid out of the several property. Fifthly I do also give & bequeath unto my son George H Buchanan part of my Land lying on the north side of Chatham creek beginning at a post betw Charles Buchanan's corner, thence to a small oak tree near the C.D. School house Spring, thence to a marked Hickory on the bank of Millard creek thence down the various current of said creek so as to Garrison's line bounding Sarah Garrison, & George Galloway, & Charles Buchanan's line to him the said George H Buchanan his heirs & assigns to have & to hold forever by him & his heirs & assigns of, only Dollars to be

Equally divided between the three girls, I do also give & bequeath unto
 the three Daughters Rachel, Jean Elsie, & Edith Elsie I said Daughters
 to have their living on the old part of the land so long as they live single or
 should prefer to live on it, I do give & bequeath unto my youngest son
 Robert the remaining part of my land standing in Mass. the under
 Sarah Garrison, George W. Buchanan, Charles Buchanan, Dennis Gury
 & William McHenry's heirs to have the said Robert his Heirs &
 assigns to have & to hold forever by his maintaining his mother
 her life term on decency & the girls so long as they stay with him
 And I give & bequeath unto my youngest son Robert all the move-
 able effects that is not above mentioned by him & my in all the
 just debts coming against my estate & hereby appoint
 my beloved wife Tracy Buchanan & George W. Buchanan and the
 Executors of this my last will & Testament, hereby Revoking &
 disannulling all wills & former wills by me made, maintain-
 ing this to be my last will & Testament, In Witness Whereof, I
 have hereunto set my hand & seal this first day of July in the
 year of our Lord 1810 -
