In the Name of God. I, Robert Campbell
of the County of Maitland in the State of Carolina in
the full Exercise of the common powers of the mind
but plainly warned of my approaching dispo-
sition, make this my last Will & Testament —
I resign my Body to its known God & my Soul
unto God who gave it in his infinite Mercy of
Paradise & acceptance through Jesus the only Redeemer
of that Portion of the population of this life
to which I have been beloved as one. I Will
& bequeath to Jabez Campbell my Blood Wife
Deborah & my Peopling of the land in which
I now live the convenience of the land & my and
a sufficient Maintenance of this Plantation on
which I now reside during her natural life
I Will & bequeath the whole and every part of
this Tract of Land on which I now reside be
the same more or less, to my Son Robert Campbell
his heirs or assigns forever, with the Restrictions
expressed above during the natural life of my Wife
Annal together with fifty Acres of Land as will
appear in Deed on the East Side of the same land
I also Will & bequeath to the above said Deborah
as far as my Will to it extends a certain Quantity
of Land taken off that which is called Cooper's
Land in the manner following beginning at the begin-
ning corner of Cooper's Tract & running with one
an Eithy line to a pin then marked with
the Letters WC & RC and from said pin without
varying the course to within line —
And I Will & bequeath as far as my Will to it
extends the whole of the Remainder of said Land
called Cooper's Tract to my son Will Campbell
his heirs or assigns forever — I Will to my son W^m

but plainly warned of my approaching
dilemma make this my last will & Testament -
I resign my Body to its Creator God & my soul
unto God who gave it in his infinite compassion of
Paradise & acceptance through Jesus the only Redeemer
of that portion of the population of this life
to which I have been beloved as one - I will
& bequeath to my dear Campbell my blood wife
dearable & ample possessions of the house in which
I now live the contents thereof belonging and
a sufficient maintenance of this plantation on
which I now reside during her natural life
this tract of land on which I now reside be
the same more or less, to my son Robert Campbell
his heirs or assigns forever. With the Residue
I will & bequeath to the natural life of my wife
I will & bequeath to the above said Robert Campbell
as far as my title to it extends a certain quantity
of land taken off that which is called Backus
land in the manner following beginning at the begin-
ning corner of Cooper's tract & running with one
an E. by S. line to a pin then marked with
the letters WC & R.C. and from said pin without
varying the line to Wilson's line -
And I will & bequeath as far as my title to it
extends the whole of the Remainder of said Backus
Cooper's tract to my son Will Campbell
his heirs or assigns forever - I will to my son Wm
Campbell ten Shillings - I will to my son in
Law Ralph ten Shillings - I will to my son
John Campbell ten Shillings - I will to my
son in Law John Beck ten Shillings -

I will to my son in Law Eschias Poth Two Shillings
 I will & bequeath to my said wife Sarah & to my
 said son Robert, jointly, the whole remainder of
 my personal property, to be committed at present to
 their full & absolute disposal, as holding the whole
 in trust: yet notwithstanding my will is that all the
 rest of my children (viz) Richard, Sarah, Mary Ann
 & Esther be now & hereafter concerned as legatees,
 that they their mother & Robert all live together
 and be content jointly for the general good of the
 family as long as they continue in their present
 circumstances; And should the time come that
 circumstances alter my will is that they be por-
 tioned off the whole stock in that manner
 which may appear good and equitable in the
 judgment of my said wife & Robert & my Trust
 friends James Cagget Esq John Beatty --
 And finally I appoint my wife Sarah & my son
 Robert, Executors & Executors of this my last will &
 of testament in confirmation of the above written
 I acknowledge & recognize this to be my last
 will & testament And in Witness thereof do hereunto
 set my hand & seal this 17th day of November. 18th 1795
