Rockingham County in the Province of North Carolina, being weak  
in body but of sound memory, blessed be god, Do this 26<sup>th</sup> day of  
August in the Year 1770 make & publish this my last will &  
Testament in the manner following that is to say first I  
assign my soul to God that gave it & my body to the grave  
to be buried in a Christian decent manner, and as to my  
womely Estate First of all I will bequeath to my son  
James Two hundred acres of Land whereon he may build  
being the lower end of my land joining James Webb's to him  
this his farm, and likewise forty pounds proclamation  
Money of No: Carolina, and likewise one negro woman  
named Indi; I likewise will bequeath to my son Robert  
Two hundred acres of Land of the middle of the above named  
tract of Land & likewise one negro woman named Will, and  
likewise my large Bible — I likewise will bequeath to  
my son George a Dark boy man — Likewise will to my  
son William the first Volume of Poor Annals, books  
to my son Charles the second Volume Likewise will and  
bequeath that my Daughter Catharine be maintained out  
of my estate at the discretion of my executors —  
I likewise will that the remainder of my estate be equally  
Divided amongst my children excepting my son in law Robert  
Lander who is only to have Twenty Shilling proclamation  
as his part of my estate — — — — —

And I constatle my sons George & Robert to be the Executors  
of this my last Will & Testament, And do utterly disallow & renounce  
I disown all & every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies,  
Bequests & Executors by me in any wise before this time named &  
ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament.

I give all my first Dells to said

I give & bequeath unto my wife Hannah her Hins  
& saddle, her bed & bed clothes & all her bed, clothes which she  
owns & likewise one third part of all my Movable wale and a  
piece of Black Thick Clothe.

I give & bequeath to my only son John the plantation on  
which I now live with all the appurtenances thereof to be by  
him possessed when he attains at the age of Twenty one years & if  
he should die before that time, my will is that it be for the use  
of my two daughters Ruth & Hannah to be equally divided  
between them.

I give & bequeath unto my two Daughters Ruth & Hannah  
the other two parts of the Movable of my estate to be equally  
divided except as hereafter Excepted.

My Will further is that my beloved wife Hannah keep my three  
children & school them & clothe & nourish them & for her help  
herein I appoint her the use of my plantation until my son  
John comes of age if she remains a widow & afterwards
