ingly Disallowing all former Wills, Legacies & Executions, Ordering
& allowing by these presents my beloved wife Priscilla with my sons
Alexander B. Jettison & Francis Becky to be my Joint Executors of
this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I hereunto
set my hand & seal this 11th day of September in the year of our
Lord 1826—
